As universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the equipment and are less at risk to destruction. These buckets are also fifty percent deeper compared to the quick-tach bucket models. This extra room makes them ideal for carrying irregular shaped loads such as moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing of roof trash and elevating roof gravel.

Quick-Tach Buckets

Quick-Tach Buckets are made for extendable-reach lift trucks. They are built to allow placement of material way beyond the reach of a loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on both sides and on the leading edge reinforces stability, resistance to wear and offers supreme durability. Quick-Tach lift buckets can in various circumstances substitute the blades and carriage of a lift truck, which may weigh anywhere between 100-700lbs. The Quick-Tach is able to pour stuff around 1.5 feet higher because of the shorter depth of its bucket.
